

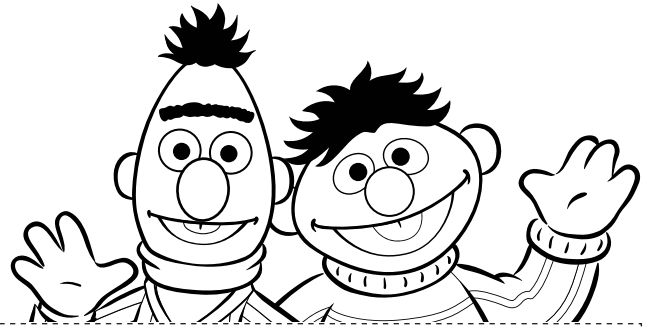

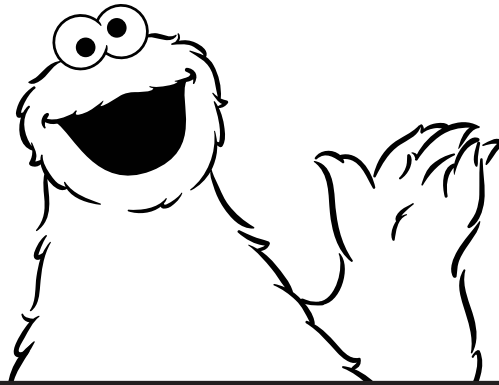

- Draw or write things that you are both good at and that you both like in the part that overlaps. This part shows how you are the same.

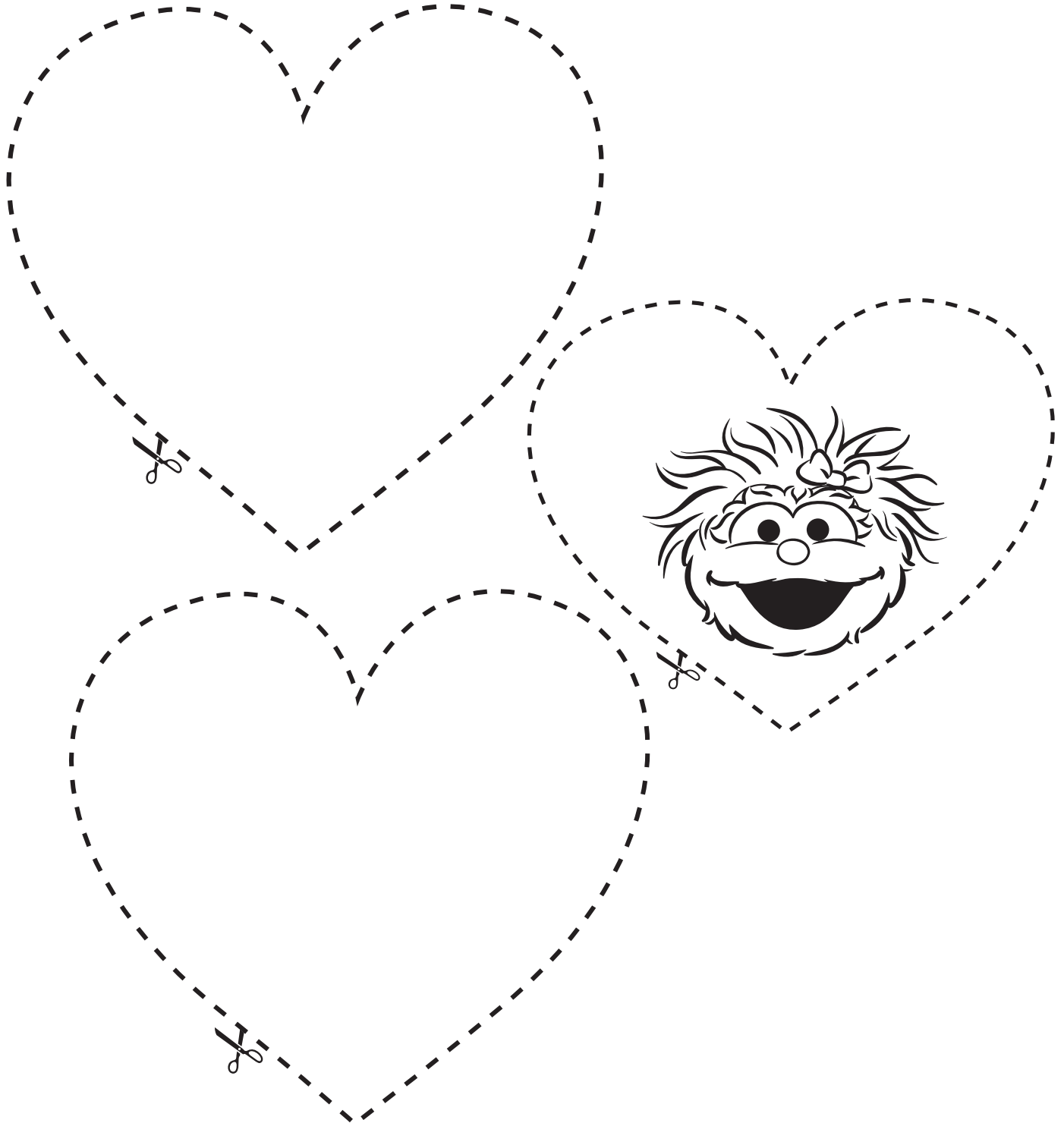
